SEARCH TIPS

Ensure **search mode** is appropriate.

Start from *Basic Search* using **keywords** to find a **relevant** article, note related **subject** heading(s), then **rerun search** using relevant headings. NB. newspaper articles DO NOT have subject headings – only keyword searches are possible.

Bring a **NZ focus** by limiting to just a NZ newspaper title in the *Search Options* box

Reported *crime* has decreased 7.8 per cent in Tokoroa and Putaruru in the past year, but *violent crime* is up. Tokoroa Senior Sergeant Fane Troy delivered the *crime* statistics report for the year to the South Waikato District Council last week.

Mr Troy told councillors that although violence had increased, most reported *crime* was resolved. "Tokoroa resolves 93.7 per cent and Putaruru solve 96.9 per cent of *violent crimes* that are reported."

Last month there were arrests after shots were fired at a Hinau St house and *gang* prospects got involved in a street fight involving hockey sticks.

No statistics were supplied on *gang* incident increases in the area, however Mr Troy said that there were active patched members of "ethnic *gangs*" like the Black Power and Mongrel Mob in the town with a new motorcycle *gang* similar to the Hells Angels on the "fringes of getting in".

Mr Troy, however, said youth *gangs* in the town were a new breed. "These youth *gangs* are a bunch of idiots with
